

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

Special Editorial

Acharya Mahapragya The Mahatma Gandhi Of 21st Century

His Holiness Acharya Mahapragya is a living embodiment of non-violence and peace, an ardent practitioner of Piety and Synthesis, a walking encyclopedia of religion and philosophy, a determined social reformer and an enlightened Ambassador of inter-faith harmony. At the age of 83, he strides on the world stage with youthful vigour in judicious blend with farsighted perception. His magnetic personality mirrors his peaceful soul, mature wisdom, deep insight into life and an inimitable communicative and highly inspiring flair which brings solace, conviction and joy to his listeners.

President of India, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam has interacted with him several times and has declared that none else could inspire blossoming of communal harmony fraternity, tolerance and love as effectively and persuasively as Mahapragyaji.

Recently on 15th October 2003, President Abdul Kalam spent his birthday with Mahapragyaji at Surat. On this occasion, specially invited 15 leading inter-faith religious and spiritual leaders and scholars interacted with them in depth and issued a Surat Spiritual Declaration.

The Declaration carries a message of contemporary relevance as well as longer term significance. It says: "In whatever field we work, be it science, technology, medicine, politics, policing, theology, religion or judiciary, we have to remain in the service of the common man whose well-being is central to all human knowledge and endeavour". President, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam emerges as the messiah of Peace, non-violence and interfaith harmony, and the speech prayer appears on the face of this newsletter.

In this message emerges the profile of Acharya Mahapragya whom the renowned Hindi Poet Ramdhari Singh "Dinkar" once described as the second Vivekananda. I will call him the Gandhi of the 21st century and he has embarked upon an "Ahimsa Yatra" on foot which has already carried him through Rajasthan and Gujarat. In the third year of this yatra, which began on 5th December 2001, he will be walking through Maharashtra and Gujarat. His message is "active Ahimsa" must become a way of life. In this time and age growing terrorism and unbridled violence at international, national and society level has

created nerve-wrecking scare and fright. His soothing message of active non-violence in thought, deed and expression at all levels of life and activity appears as a rainbow in the sky. He calls upon humanity to practice compassion first and not just preach it. His pursuit of compassion is a pursuit of the ideal of "live, let live and help to let live". His spiritual prescriptions advocate a healthy and harmonious interdependence between Humans, Nature and other living beings. Mutual exploitation is only leading towards degradation and depletion of the entire living environment around us without which we, the human beings cannot survive. Emancipate the world before seeking your own emancipation. Your own soul would be much nobler & purer, more enlightened and responsive if you engage in the service of others with your heart full of tolerance (sahishnuta), cooperation (sahyog), equality (samta) and synthesis (samanvaya).

Acharya Mahapragya is the 10th Acharya and Head of the Jain Terapanth Sect. His predecessor, the renowned Acharya Tulsi had charted the path of universalizing the message of Ahimsa, Aparigraha and Anekant. Mahapragyaji has given this mission a farsighted vision, depth and expanse.

Mahapragyaji has been instrumental in bringing home to the global society the enormous benefits of meditation through the technique of Preksha Dhyan. It synthesizes the harmones thereby eliminating negative emotions and building up positive emotions of love and humility. Meditation helps in motivation, concentration, relaxation and visualization. It is a precious gift to humanity.

He is a highly articulate and expressive writer and a sensitive poet. His books are treasures of knowledge and wisdom. In essence his writings convey to humanity the need to build bridges between religion, spirituality, science, development and environment. Here is a totally openhearted, open-minded saint who has consistently and convincingly argued for inseparable linkage between science and spirituality.

We salute with veneration this outstanding spiritual scientist, reformist saint, determined non-violent revolutionary and an abiding votary of peace, peaceful coexistence and harmonious

interdependence.



NEWS OF INTEREST

- ❖ The forth Parliament of World's religions will take place in Barcelona, Spain from 7th to 13th July 2004. It is one of the most significant events of the Universal Forum of cultures, which is supported by UNESCO. The first Parliament in Chicago was attended by Late Shri Virchand Gandhi, who represented Jain Tradition.
- ❖ The preliminary meeting of the fourth parliament of World Religion was held at Delhi on 7th to 10th Dec 2003. Shri Pratap Bhogilal Chairman Board of Trustees of World Jain Confederation attended this meeting. There is also another meeting in connection to the forth Parliament meet of World religion in Kochi from 13th to 16th Dec 03. The subject was 'Harmony and Non-violence'. Dr. Hema Pokhran from USA is the key person in this world Fellowship of Inter-Religion Councils.
- ❖ BBCI Launches Jainism Website: BBC Religion and Ethics launched the Jainism website on 7th December 2003, which communicates the philosophy and culture of Jain Religion. The newly launched website will allow people worldwide to appreciate and understand the Jain values of Ahimsa, Aprigraha and Anekant as a highly relevant and essential part of modern living.
- Mahendra Mehta Honored in columbus, OHIO: Mahendra Mehta of Mumbai has been honored and awarded a purse of \$100,000 by Children at Columbus, Ohio. He has been helping runaway children from streets of Mumbai educating them and teaching them skills so that they return to society with respect. He also Distributes artificial legs to handicaps.

❖ JAIN DERASAR IN U.K. Places of worship are a necessity for mankind for finding peace and solace. The importance of this is even more so these days where people are constantly facing stress and strain.

The Mahavir Foundation in U.K. is planning a modern complex with a temple, which apart from the Jain temple will provide various amenities for the benefit of the younger generation in London at Brookshill Harrow Weald. This would be the first Jain temple in London.

Funds requirement is £Stg. 200,000 and the Mahavir Foundation has decided to raise £Stg. 100,000 in London for this purpose and would like World Jain Confederation (WJC) to raise an equivalent of £Stg. 100,000 in India.

Mahavir Foundation jointly with WJC Europe Chapter is planning a cycling project for children and elders from all different faiths who are invited to participate from U.K. to Paris, France. The money raised from this will be utilized for building the complex. WJC in one of its earlier meeting had decided to support such a project. WJC has also suggested to the Mahavir Foundation that they should jointly with WJC Europe Chapter build a small hostel for students which can be either within the complex or close to it.

The WJC will have to mostly raise these funds as Devdravya, which would enable payments to be made in India for cost of marble, other materials, salaries of craftsmen payable in India, etc. for the construction of temple.

Religious intolerance is increasingly pervading in societies all around the world. The environment, ecology and culture of humanity in the world have been disturbed tremendously endangering existence on the planet Earth. Science has made immense progress for materialistic affluence. At the same time there has been a continuous spiritual degradation with materialism and consumerism prevailing unbounded. Man's greed for power and money is getting limitless. Religious fundamentalism has led and is leading to conflict between communities and nations.



Creator's Message

God Has Created the Human Being with Brain and Thinking Faculty. He Has Commanded His creation to use the faculty with reasoning to reach His image.

This is the mission of human life.

Science is a recent boon God bestowed upon mankind. Science with reasoning becomes the capital of the society. Spirituality is a special quality God has given to the human being. The duty of the human being is to discover it and use it for the benefit of all.

In whatever field we work, be it science, technology, medicine, politics, theology, religion or judiciary, we have to remain in the service of the common man whose well being is central to all human knowledge and endeavour.

The present Condition

Even while the above is the main focus of human life we find that our nation is facing loss of confidence in itself, at various levels. There is lack of tolerance for others' religion, faith and philosophy or viewpoints; there is lack of harmony; there is lack of moral, ethical and cultural values and there is lack of sensitivity to poverty and inequality. Womanhood is not given its rightful place. There are various social problems like employment opportunities and the resultant rise in crime and other social evils like addiction to drugs etc. thus there are various forms of violence spreading in the country. While science and technology and economic growth would help in solving some of these problems, it is possible to manage these complex forces to the benefit of humanity only when the dimension of spirituality is embedded in human knowledge and efforts.

Dimensions of Spirituality

Every religion has a central component – spirituality driven by compassion and love. Rationality and logic are intrinsic to science and spirituality. A spiritual experience is the goal of a deeply religious person whereas a major discovery or

an invention is the goal of a scientific mind. If both the aspects are unified, amalgamated in our own patterns, we can transcend to that level of thinking, in which unity is a cohesive concept. Then the enlightenment of citizenship will take place. For this environment, the two major components — Science and Spirituality have to interact. A Peace prayer can be the foundation for both.

Spiritual Component of Religion

In our country, certain religions are presently being subjected to tremendous stress due to violence in body and mind. If we study the history of India over 3000 years, we will find that the country has always stood for peace. It worked for peace; it prayed for peace to live in peace. But these days, peace seems to be endangered due to societal dynamics described briefly earlier. So, how does one bring back peace? Paradoxically, the 'I' in us wants peace. Nevertheless, to get peace one has to first get ride of the 'I' and 'me' as per our scriptures. This



may be a tough proposition. For in virtually every sentence, every thought we are dictated by 'I' and 'me' the ego will vanish. When the ego vanishes, hatred fades away. When hatred goes away, violence in mind and body will disappear. Therefore, peace comes when forsake "I" and "Me". The spiritual goal of every religion is indeed violence free individual in mind and body and thereby a peaceful society. Removal of poverty is one of the components for realizing peace.

Removal of Poverty

We realize that the 300 million young citizen who are below 20 years of age in India want peace, prosperity, happiness and safety. It is our responsibility as religious and spiritual leaders to carry out this mission of removal of poverty from our people.

Fortunately, there is a road map to go to the India 2020 of our national dream. That entails working intensively on five important areas that have been identified. Theses are agriculture and food processing, education and healthcare, information and communication technology, infrastructure development including networking of rivers and providing urban amenities in rural areas. If the villagers prosper, the states prosper; if the states prospers, India can prosper. Such a network of prosperity is extremely important to realize the vision of the nation. Removal of poverty means addressing several related elements like removal of illiteracy and providing good governance as it is vital to ensure that funds allotted for the poor and the earnings by the poor people are not frittered away in various forms of social evils like corruption. This is where making of an enlightened citizen comes in. this aguires amoral, ethical and spiritual partnership. We have considered how this partnership can be developed.

Religion a beautiful partner in the Nation's Prosperity

Religions are like exquisite gardens, places full of surpassing beauty and tranquility, like sacred groves filled with beautiful birds and their melodious songs. Religions are beautiful gardens, but they are islands. They are enchanting islets, veritable oasis for the soul and the spirit. But they are islands nevertheless. If we can connect all these islands with love and compassion, in a 'garland

project', we will have a peaceful, happy and prosperous India in fort of us. Universal trusts embodied in each religion are very similar and they will help to form the bridge thus reinforcing basic unity.

Another fact of today is that the intellectual gap between the opinion maker class and the masses is rather large. The removal of the gap is best done by spreading knowledge and increasing the knowledge base of every citizen in all vital aspects of their lives. As the number of enlightened citizens' increases, the ability to cope with and transform problems also increases. In order to achieve this, in addition to concentrating on education of the youth, there is also need for continual education of adult population and senior citizens on values of lives and about the basic spiritual unity of all religions.

Education and intellectual activities are vital. In addition theses values have to be reinforced in every citizen through specific project, which can bring people together, irrespective of their social levels or religious beliefs.

GARLAND PROJECTS

In order to do so we resolve to undertake the following projects and activities.

Project 1: Celebration of Inter-Religious Festivals

Every month in all parts of India there can be a multi-religious gathering to convey the core message attempted in the prayer of peace and about the basic truth contained in various religions. Such a prayer shopped be preceded by prayers from all religions practiced in that part of the country by respective religious and spiritual leaders in the presence of the people. Each month the day selected could be a holy day from one religion: Islam, Hindu, Christianity, Sikh, Parsi, Jain Buddhist etc. Regular conduct of such meetings by all religious leaders and people from different religions respecting holy days of other religions will send a powerful message. If possible such gatherings can take place at the religious places where all persons from other religions also can gather on that day. People should also exchange pleasantries and sweets during theses meetings, as it the practice in some parts of the country where unity of minds prevails. In addition, in order to spread the message of equality to everybody on that day a 'langar' (community kitchen and eating)



can be arranged so that all people eat common food sitting side by side.

How to organise these? We believe that, if all the religious spiritual groups build strong connectivity between their own beautiful islands of happiness and solace, it is possible to turn these monthly meetings into mass movements for respecting each other's rituals, ways of life or view points. It will bring harmony and love. Peace and happiness will follow.

Project 2: Multi- Religious Projects

So far, religious groups have taken many efforts towards the removal of poverty and the accruing misery, in large or small scale, but in isolation. We will launch additionally a number of multi-religious projects in education, healthcare and water supply as well as for generating entrepreneurship and employment, to help the poor people. People will see for themselves that multiple religions are working together for common good. These efforts will elevate religions in the minds of the people and the nation will benefit.

Project 3: Education in and with the ambience of Unity of Religions

All religious educational institutions operating in different parts of the country should enroll children from other religions in certain proportions and imbibe values such as religious tolerance, righteousness. The real purpose and the unity of religions should be embedded in the minds of the students. These children who are the pillars of tomorrow, will foster a sense of peace and amenity between themselves and for others. Simple exercises to reinforce positive thinking can also attempted. In addition to these, specially designed value based educational material should be generated so that they are supplied in large scale to the children. Attempts should also be made for large-scale dissemination of these through various forms of media. It may not necessary to begin an exercise to generate these materials, as a large number of them are available in India and abroad. It may be necessary to search for them and shape them to suit our special needs.

Project 4: Inter-Faith Dialogue

In addition to the above projects impinging directly on common people and citizens, it is also necessary to have a continual Inter-Faith-Dialogue between the religious and spiritual heads as well as scholars. This dialogue can address, among other things, minimum common code between religions, method of creating congenial atmosphere for various religions, solution for some of the burning problems of the society etc. Proceedings of and conclusion from such an Interfaith Dialogues can be widely disseminated among people through various electronic and print media. Models for these Dialogues exist in some other countries as well. Maximum benefit may be derived from such knowledge sharing in addition to finding our own unique methods.

Project 5: National Level Independent and Autonomous organisation managed by religious

and spiritual leaders as well as scholars and enlightened citizen

In addition to the above projects impinging directly on common people and citizens, it is also necessary to have a continual Inter-Faith-Dialogue between the religious and spiritual heads as well as scholars. This dialogue can address, among other things, minimum common code between religions, methods of creating congenial atmosphere for various religions, solutions for some of the burning problems of the society etc. Proceedings of and conclusion from such an Inter-Faith Dialogue can be widely disseminated among people through various electronic and print media. Models for these Dialogues exist in some other countries as well. Maximum benefit may be derived from such knowledge sharing in addition to finding our own unique methods.

CONCLUSION:

On the whole, the congregation of spiritual and religious leaders came to the conclusion that with the above five key elements the "Garland Project" for "Unity of Minds" and for creating "Enlightened Citizens" in India and eventually in the world, can be successful if we start taking action in all earnestness after this "SURAT SPIRITUAL DECLARATION" made on 15th October 2003 in the presence of Hon'ble President of India.

India can emerge as a Developed Nation by 2020 with its civilization heritage and value systems spreading harmony and peace to the whole world. This "Unity of Minds can be achieved even while keeping intact the rich diversity of rites, rituals, ideas and beliefs amongst us and blending them with modern knowledge and skills.

આ કારમી મોધવારીના યુગમાં મર્યાદિત આવક ધરાવતી વ્યક્તિને પોતાના પુત્ર કે પુત્રીના લગ્ન વખતે ભોગવવી પડતી તક્લીફોના નિરાકરણ રૂપે યોજવામાં આવતા સમૂહ લગ્ન સમાજ માટે આશીર્વાદ સમાન છે. આ પરિસ્થિતિના ઉકેલરૂપે સમાજ પ્રત્યેનું ૠૂણ અદા કરવાની ફરજના ભાગરૂપે જૈન જાગૃતિ સેન્ટરો દ્વારા સમુહલગ્નોનું આયોજન કરવામાં આવે છે.

તદ્ઉપરાંત દરકે અલગ અલગ સેન્ટર્સ દ્વારા રક્તદ્યન શિબિર, નેત્રયજ્ઞ, સર્વ રોગ નિદ્યન કેમ્પ, માનવ રાહત વાર્તાલાપ પ્રવચનો, પર્યુષણ વ્યાખ્યાનમાળાઓ. દર્શન યાત્રાઓ, તિર્થયાત્રાઓ, તપસ્વીઓનું બહુમાન, ધાર્મિક શિક્ષણ શિબિરો જેવી વિવિધલક્ષી પ્રવૃત્તિઓનું આયોજન કરવામાં આવે છે. તેમજ દરેક સેન્ટર્સ તરફથી દરેક મહીને એક કે તેથી વધારે વખત દરેક સભ્યોનું સ્નેહમિલન-સહભોજન યોજાય છે. આ રીતે દરેક સભ્યો એક બીજાના પરિચયથી વધું નિક્ટ આવે છે. જેમાં ધાર્મિક-સામાજિક અને વ્યવહારિક વિચારોનું મોકળા મનથી આદાનપ્રદાન થાય છે. આમ, જૈન જાગૃતિ સેન્ટર માત્ર ભોજન અને મનોરંજનની સંસ્થા ન બની રહેતા પોતાની સેવાકીય અને સામાજિક પ્રવૃત્તિઓ દ્વારા સમાજ ઉપયોગી સંસ્થા બની રહે છે. અને એટલા માટે જ જ્યારે જ્યારે જૈન જાગૃતિ સેન્ટરનું કોઇપણ નવું સેન્ટર ખુલે છે, ત્યારે સમયની મર્યાદા પહેલા જ તેની સભ્ય સંખ્યા છલકાઇ જાય છે, જે તેની લોકપ્રિયતાનો સદ્ધર પુરાવો છે.
